BLM is committed to reducing its impact on the environment and to contributing to a more sustainable society. We will:

- Implement an environmental management system to produce a cycle of continuous environmental improvement, to monitor, set base lines, produce and agree targets and review.
- Comply with relevant environmental legislation.
- Engender a staff culture of environmental excellence with senior management taking responsibility and leading by example.

- Minimise noise nuisance, litter and visual intrusion to neighbours.
